

## **SUPPLY LIST**

Stamps: Delicate Pines Stamp Set

**Dies:** Delicate Pines Dies

Paper: Basic White Thick Cardbase 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4", Basic White card front 4" x 5-1/4",

Blueberry Bushel for die cutting, Cloud Cover for Die cutting.

Ink: Blueberry Bushel, Balmy Blue, Versamark,

**Embellishments:** Faceted Snowflakes

Other: Heat tool, Wow Opaque Bright White embossing powder, Embossing Tool Kit, Blending brushes

## **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. This card requires restraint & delicate hands.
- 2. Fold & burnish card base. Set aside.
- 3. Using Blueberry Bushel Ink, stamp the sentiment about 1" from the bottom of the card panel.
- 4. Using the two blending brushes (light & dark blue) softly blend on the Balmy Blue ink on the basic white card front and then the Blueberry Bushel ink after. Be mindful to avoid the sentiment area and try to leave white space.

Pro TIP: Use the white grid mat to work on, ink the brush with the appropriate ink, tap off on the grid mat and then very lightly brush on the ink in very soft circles. You can pick up the ink from the grid mat rather than re-inking the brush. Use the light colour in a "Y" formation avoiding the sentiment and then fill in with the darker blue. Use a very soft delicate hand, blend in soft circles and use very little ink.

- 5. Ink up the small snowflake stamp with Balmy Blue and randomly stamp around the card front.
- 6. Ink the small snowflake stamp with Blueberry Bushel and then stamp off on scrap and then stamp on your project. Randomly stamp a couple of times. Set this panel aside.
- 7. Using the embossing buddy anti-static bag, rub heavily on the Blueberry Bushel 4" x 4" card and the 2 Cloud Cover cardstocks.
- 8. Using Versamark ink, stamp the large snowflake on the Blueberry Bushel cardstock. Ink the small snowflake and stamp on the Cloud Cover cards.
- 9. Placing the VersaMark inked cardstock in the Embossing Tray, sprinkle Wow embossing powder over the image and gently tap off. Use the brush to brush away any stray powder particles. Heat the embossing powder using the heat tool, making sure to use the tweezers to hold the cardstock and not burn your fingers.
- 10. Once heat embossed, use the dies to die cut the snowflakes out being mindful to use the die that will cut the "spokes" from the snowflakes as well. You can die cut all at the same time.
- 11. Adhere the snowflakes to the card base using a large dimensionals for the large snowflake and the mini dimensionals for the smaller snowflake.
- 12. Adorn your card using 3 faceted snowflakes embellishments around the sentiment.
